21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§34 is enacted to read:

23 34. St. Joseph's College. Such sign or signs shall be
24 provided by St. Joseph's College and installed and main-
25 tained by the Maine Turnpike Authority at exit 8 and shall
26 conform with standards established by the Maine Turnpike
27 Authority, and shall be worded as follows:
