All insurance companies writing private passenger automobile liability and physical damage insurance in the State shall allow an appropriate reduction in premium charges to all eligible persons subject to this chapter.

§2953. Certificate of completion of drivers course

17 Upon successfully completing the approved course, each
18 participant shall be issued by the course's sponsoring
19 agency, a certificate which shall be the basis of qualifica20 tion for the discount on insurance.

21 §2954. Course to be taken every 3 years

Each participant must take an approved course every 3 years to continue to be eligible for the discount on insurance.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to provide that any schedule or rates or rating plan rules for private passenger automobile liability and physical damage insurance submitted to or filed with the Superintendent of Insurance shall provide for an appropriate reduction in premium charges for those insured 55 years of age and over for a 3-year period after successfully completing a motor vehicle accident prevention course approved by the Motor Vehicle Division.
