14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21	This amendment clarifies that the Priority Social Service Program may not be used to match Social Services Block Grant funds, formerly the United States Social Security Act, Title XX. The Congress, in creating the block grants, no longer requires a state match for this program. The amendment does not affect the ability of the Priority Social Service Program to match the Federal Older Americans Act and other appropriate federal funds for priority services identified in the original legislation.
