STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will ensure that services which are provided to eligible recipients under the Maine Medical Assistance Program shall be reimbursable whether they are performed by a physician or a dentist as long as either is licensed and qualified to perform the service. Presently, there are some services which have been provided by dentists to Maine Medical Assistance recipients for which the dentist is not being reimbursed even though the dentist was licensed and qualified to perform the service.

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
