18 **RESOLVE, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities**  
19 **on Account of Taxes Lost Due to Lands Being**  
20 **Classified under the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law.**

22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the  
23 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after ad-  
24 journment unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the municipalities have been reimbursed 75% of  
26 the tax loss pursuant to Public Law 1977, chapter 720,  
27 section 3, and there remains moneys due the municipalities  
28 pursuant to Public Law 1977, chapter 282, section 1, and  
29 Public Law 1981, chapter 517; and

30 Whereas, the municipalities currently need the remain-  
31 ing reimbursement funds due to the taxes lost; and

1       Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
2 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-  
3 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as  
4 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
5 peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

6       **Reimbursements to be paid to certain municipalities.**  
7 **Resolved:** That the following designated municipalities be  
8 reimbursed for the sums indicated totaling \$116,346.50 under  
9 the provisions of the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law pursuant to  
10 the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 578, subsection 1:
