6 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1845, L.D. 1841, Bill,
7 "AN ACT to Establish Municipal Cost Components for Services
8 to be Rendered in Fiscal Year 1982-83."

9 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
10 emergency preamble and before the emergency clause and
11 inserting in its place the following:

12 'Municipal cost components for services rendered. In
13 accordance with the Revised Statutes, Title 36, chapter 115,
14 the Legislature determines that the net municipal cost com-
15 ponent for services and reimbursements to be rendered in
16 fiscal year 1982-83 is \$6,145,512 as reflected by the fol-
17 lowing tabulation:

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This amendment eliminates the adjustments other than
13 rounding supplemental abatements and accounts' receivable
14 made in the original bill for fiscal years 1979 through
15 1981. It also reduces the amount set for education, and it
16 reduces the amount set for county reimbursement, as a result
17 of revised county requests and the use of surplus funds for
18 county expenditures.
