6 7 8 9 10	This bill revises the payment systems followed by the Department of Human Services for compensating operators of boarding care facilities and adult foster homes. All boarding care facility operators are now treated equally in that each is compensated pursuant to a reasonable cost-related reimbursement system. The bill also increases the amount of reimbursement received by operators of adult foster homes.
