18 **AN ACT to Expand the Territorial Limits**
19 **of Van Buren Light and Power District.**
20

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 P&SL 1917, c. 182, §1, as repealed and replaced by P&SL
23 1979, c. 38, is repealed and the following enacted in its
24 place:

25 Sec. 1. Territorial limits; name; purposes; bond issue
26 authorized. The following described territory and the
27 people within the territory, namely all of the Town of Van
28 Buren, excepting that area contained by original Lots 237
29 through 248, inclusive; and so much of the Town of Hamlin as
30 is included in original Lots 306 through 309, inclusive; is
31 hereby created a body politic and corporate under the name
32 of the Van Buren Light and Power District; with the right of
33 making, generating, purchasing, selling, distributing and

1 supplying gas or electricity, or both, for lighting, heat-
2 ing, manufacturing or mechanical purposes, and to sell the
3 gas or electricity for street lighting purposes and to light
4 all public and private buildings, houses, stores, ware-
5 houses, mills and business places in the district, and like-
6 wise for heating, domestic and power purposes. The district
7 may build such system as may be required to carry out the
8 purposes stated in this section, or acquire by purchase or
9 the right of eminent domain any existing system or systems
10 and enlarge or extend the system or systems as circumstances
11 require. The district may also issue bonds in such amount
12 as may appear necessary to fully accomplish these purposes
13 with a view to furnishing the inhabitants of the district
14 with gas and electricity for all purposes to which the same
15 may be advantageously applied.

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

17 The purpose of this bill is to redefine the territorial
18 limits of the Van Buren Light and Power District.
