af	Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate unti fter the beginning of the next state fiscal year; and						
Μ	Whereas, unemployment is on the rise in the State of aine due to recessionary economic conditions; and						
C	Whereas, the Maine Job Service, a program funded nrough federal funds, is designed to provide essential bunseling and job location services to those who are unemployed; and						

1 2 3	Whereas, funds for the operation of the Maine Job Service in federal fiscal year 1982 have been severely cut, retroactively, by the Federal Government; and
4 5 6	Whereas, reductions in Maine Job Service funds means the immediate closing of 7 Maine Job Service offices around the State; and
