15 **AN ACT to Provide Retired Teachers, State Employees**  
16 **and Beneficiaries with a Cost-of-living Increase.**

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

19 **Sec. 1. Retirement allowances.** Notwithstanding the  
20 Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1128, subsection 1,  
21 monthly retirement allowances of retired teachers, state  
22 employees or their beneficiaries shall be increased by \$1  
23 for each year of the members' creditable service.

24 **Sec. 2. Appropriations; allocations.** The following funds  
25 are appropriated from the General Fund and allocated from  
26 the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill would provide a one-time across-the-board  
15 increase in retirement allowances to retired state employ-  
16 ees, teachers and their beneficiaries. The increase is  
17 based on the number of creditable service the employee  
18 earned under the Maine State Retirement System.
