COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1907, L.D. 1882, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Maine Traveler Information Services
Act."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before
the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the summer tourist season will begin before
this legislation would normally take effect; and

Whereas, the improvements permitted by this legislation
and proposed in new regulations drafted by the Department of
Transportation will be of significant benefit to Maine busi-
nesses and the general public; and

Whereas, it is vital that the business community be
able to avail itself of these benefits in time for its peak
season; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in
the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
