1 2 3	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
4 5	Whereas, the summer tourist season will begin before this legislation would normally take effect; and
6 7 8 9	Whereas, the improvements permitted by this legislation and proposed in new regulations drafted by the Department of Transportation will be of significant benefit to Maine businesses and the general public; and
0 !1 !2	Whereas, it is vital that the business community be able to avail itself of these benefits in time for its peak season; and
13 14 15 16	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
.8 !9	Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
