18 19	Sec. 4. 25 MRSA §2436-A, 2nd sentence, as amended by PL 1981, c. 115, is further amended to read:
20 21 22 23 24	No person, firm or corporation may burn debris out of doors other than when the ground is covered with snow, except between the hours of 5 p.m. and 12 midnight without a permit from a municipal fire chief, town forest fire warden or forest ranger.'
25 26	Further amend the Amendment by renumbering sections 3 and 4 to be sections 5 and 6.
27	STATEMENT OF FACT
28 29 30 31	There is confusion concerning the provisions of the Revised Statutes, Title 12, chapters 215 and 807; Title 25, section 2436-A and Title 38, section 599 concerning open burning. This amendment makes it clear that no permit is
