17 **AN ACT Making Adjustments to the**
18 **Allocations from the Highway Fund for**
19 **the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1982**
20 **and June 30, 1983.**

22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
23 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
24 unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until
26 after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

27 Whereas, certain program cuts are necessary before July
28 1, 1982; and

29 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
30 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
31 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
32 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
33 peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Allocations from Highway Fund. Allocations from the
3 Highway Fund for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1982 and
4 June 30, 1983 are adjusted as follows:
