17	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
18 19	<b>2 MRSA §6</b> , as last amended by PL 1981, c. 501, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
20	§6. Salaries subject to adjustment by Governor
21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29	Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Gover- nor is authorized to adjust the salaries of the following state officials within the salary ranges indicated in this section. The adjustment may be at the time of appointment of the official and subsequently as provided by law. The salary ranges shall be as provided by law; except that for the purposes of this section, each salary range shall be increased by 2 steps in the range otherwise provided by law. No other state salary shall be paid to these officials.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill includes reference to the Commissioner of 19 Corrections and adjusts the salary ranges of cabinet members 20 top reflect their management and policy responsibilities. 21 The positions affected are: Commissioner of Agriculture, and Rural Resources; Commissioner of Inland Fisheries 22 Food 23 and Wildlife: Commissioner of Marine Resources: Director 24 Energy Resources Office; and the Public Advocate.
