16 **AN ACT to Exempt the York Water District**
17 **from the Revised Statutes, Title 35, chapter**
18 **262, Relating to Local Control of Water**
19 **Districts in Existence Prior to January**

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

23 **35 MRSA §3226, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 447, §1, is**
24 **amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:**

25 The provisions of this chapter do not apply to any proposed
26 project, bond issue or sale already in existence on January
27 1, 1982.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt the project or projects already started when Title 35, section 3226 became effective as the Legislature never intended that these be included. This exemption will clear ambiguities raised by bond council in connection with an existing project of the York Water District.

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
