18 19 20	'In order to assure continuity of the program, the previous rules under the federal program shall remain in effect until replaced by new state rules.'
21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24 25 26	To assure continuity of the Residential Conservation Service program, this amendment keeps the rules from the federal program in effect after the federal program ends or is significantly cut back until new state rules are adopted to take their place.
