3 STATEMENT OF FACT

In view of the substantial progress made by the State in stimulating interest by the present distributor of natural gas in providing service to unserved areas, the sunset date on new franchises and termination date on inactive existing franchises is deleted. The Public Utilities Commission will still review distribution service and a joint select committee of the Legislature will continue oversight. The Chairman of the Public Utilities Commission has been replaced on that committee by a staff member.
