	AN ACT to Reduce Discrimination by Allowing Employees of Local Districts which Participate in the Social Security System the Option of Withdrawal from the Maine State Retirement System.
B	e it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1092, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:
w Se	5-A. Membership in districts which participate in t ocial Security System. Participating local districts hich employees are covered under the United States Soc ecurity System shall allow optional withdrawal from t aine State Retirement System for their members.
F	rom September 1, 1982, membership in the Maine Sta etirement System shall be optional for all those who a nployees of the district.
N er	ew employees may join either at the commencement of the new employees may join either at the commence-

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1 ment of their employment, as long as they are still employ-2 ees of the participating local district and the district 3 continues as a participating unit.

4 Employees who are participating members of the state system
5 who wish to withdraw from the system may withdraw their con6 tributions, as provided for in section 1096, at their own
7 discretion.

- 8 <u>Employees who have previously withdrawn from the system may</u> 9 <u>choose to rejoin within 3 years of their withdrawal, pro-</u> 10 vided that:
- 11A. They repay to the system an amount equivalent to12the withdrawn contributions and, in addition, the13amount of interest which would be required of termi-14nated employees who had become reemployed and had15elected to rejoin the system and to repay their contri-16butions; and
- 17 The district is still a <u>participating</u> local Β. dis-Maine 18 membership in the trict allowing new State 19 This Retirement System. right to rejoin shall be 20 limited to one occurrence.

An employee who withdraws from the system and rejoins within the 3-year period shall not receive any retirement credit, and shall not be required to make any contribution for any year or part of a year during which he was withdrawn from the system.

26 Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect Septem-27 ber 1, 1982.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

29 This bill requires local participating districts where 30 employees are also covered by Social Security to offer the 31 option of coverage under only one system. It also establishes provisions for the withdrawal of members and their 32 contributions, for rejoining and for the status of retire-33 contributions during the period of with-34 ment credit and The bill allows flexibility to employees to decide 35 drawal. 36 whether to join the state system or the state and the fed-37 eral systems.

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
