21 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
22 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
23 unless enacted as emergencies; and

24 Whereas, several state and agency liquor stores located
25 in communities with only one store are scheduled to close at
26 the end of February 1982; and

27 Whereas, unless the 10-mile restriction is changed it
28 will be impossible to replace the stores in those communi-
29 ties if there is a state or agency store within 10 miles;
30 and

31 Whereas, it is important that this change be made
32 before the existing stores are closed or very soon there-
33 after so that replacement stores can be provided for in
34 those communities; and
