16 **RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Fort**
17 **Kent for Loss due to Erroneous Increase**
18 **in the 1981 State Valuation.**

20 Town of Fort Kent reimbursed. Resolved: That, not-
21 withstanding any limitation imposed by law, the State Tax
22 Assessor is authorized to credit or pay from departmental
23 funds the sum of \$55,195.08 to reimburse the Town of Fort
24 Kent, as a full and final settlement of its claim against
25 the State for loss due to an erroneous increase in its 1981
26 state valuation.

27 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

28 The Town of Fort Kent experienced a loss of \$55,195.08
29 due to an erroneous increase in the 1981 state valuation.
30 This total represents losses in the following areas and
31 amounts:

1	School assessment	\$36,936.00
2	County tax	9,096.08
3	Welfare	2,220.00
4	Incinerator facility	6,943.00

5 The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the State
6 Tax Assessor to reimburse the Town of Fort Kent by either a
7 credit or funds from the department appropriation.

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
