6 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2071, L.D. 2012, Bill,
7 "AN ACT Creating the Housing Opportunities for Maine (HOME)
8 Program and Governing Program Funds Appropriated by this
9 Act to the Maine State Housing Authority."

10 Amend the bill in section 1, in that part designated
11 "§4732." in subsection 2, paragraph A, last line (page 4,
12 line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word
13 "income" the following underlined words and punctuation: ,"
14 provided that where funds are used by the authority to
15 reduce the rate of interest on or the principal amount of
16 mortgage loans made to assist first-time buyers in purchas-
17 ing owner-occupied single family dwellings, these dwellings
18 shall contain no more than 2 units.


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STATEMENT OF FACT
