15 AN ACT to Provide for Identifying
16 Seed Potatoes.

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

19 7 MRS A §2105 is enacted to read:

20 §2105. Seed potatoes to be labeled

21 All seed potatoes exported from this State to Canada or
22 imported to this State from Canada shall be in 75-pound or
23 100-pound new burlap bags marked "FOR SEED USE ONLY."

24 STATEMENT OF FACT

25 This bill provides for identifying seed potatoes going
26 to or coming from Canada. It will help stop the practice of
27 Canadian potatoes entering the United States in bulk

1 quantities labeled as "seed" and then being repackaged in
2 bags and sold as "tablestock."

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
