6 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2162, L.D. 2062, Bill,
7 "AN ACT Relating to the Sale and Purchase of Herring."

8 Amend the Bill in that part designated "\$6546." by
9 striking out all of subsections 1 and 2 and inserting in
10 their place the following:

11 1. Contents of acknowledgment. Unless otherwise
12 agreed to by the parties, the buyer shall insert in the
13 written acknowledgment all information necessary for a com-
14 plete understanding of the transaction, including the price
15 and quantity, and a provision for payment at a time not
16 later than 14 days after delivery of the herring.

17 2. Payments. Unless otherwise agreed to by the par-
18 ties, the buyer shall make all payments to the fisherman, or
19 his agent, in money or in money equivalent, which includes,
20 but is not limited to, credit against any outstanding
21 indebtedness the fisherman may have to the buyer.

22 STATEMENT OF FACT

23 The purposes of this amendment are:

24 1. To give the buyer a reasonable time to make the re-
25 quired payment to the fisherman;

26 2. To make clear that the phrase "money equivalent"
27 includes credits against any outstanding indebtedness a
28 fisherman may have to a buyer; and

29 3. To make clear that the provisions of the bill may
30 be modified by agreement of the parties.
