16 AN ACT to Amend the Charter of St.  
17 Mark's Home in Augusta.  
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20 P&SL, 1871, c. 560, §1, as amended by PL 1965, c. 64,  
21 is further amended to read:

22 **Sec. 1. Corporators; name; real and personal property;**  
23 **purpose.** The rector, wardens and vestry of St. Mark's  
24 Church, Augusta, and their successors in office, are hereby  
25 constituted a body corporate and politic, by the name of St.  
26 Mark's Home for Needy Women, with authority to take and hold  
27 property, real and personal, for establishing and maintain-  
28 ing in said Augusta, a home for needy women, of the value of  
29 \$300,000, and to manage and control the same for the purpose  
30 aforesaid; and said corporation shall have all the powers  
31 and privileges and be subject to all the duties and liabili-  
32 ties of similar corporations in this State.
