of the Legislature.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

17

The purpose of this amendment is to require prior

18

approval of the Legislature before any purchase of land or

19

resources in the unorganized territories. This will serve

20

to put the public on notice and provide an opportunity to be

21

heard on any such transactions.
