16 **RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes**
17 **and Authorizing Expenditures of Somerset**
18 **County for the Year 1982.**

20 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
21 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after ad-
22 journment unless enacted as emergencies; and

23 Whereas, Somerset County has certain expenses and lia-
24 bilities which must be met as they become due; and

25 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year
26 1982 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed in order
27 to provide the required revenue for the county; and

28 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
29 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
30 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
31 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
32 peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

1 **Sec. 1. Somerset County; taxes apportioned. Resolved:**
 2 That the following sum is hereby granted as a tax on
 3 Somerset County to be apportioned, assessed, collected and
 4 applied to the purposes of paying debts and necessary
 5 expenses of the county as authorized herein, and for other
 6 purposes of law for the calendar year 1982:

7 **1982 TAX**
 8 **\$841,732**

9 ; and be it further

10 **Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized. Resolved:**
 11 That the following sums, based on the county budget filed in
 12 the office of the Secretary of State, are authorized as General
 13 Fund expenditures by the county during the calendar
 14 year 1982 in the specific total amounts of expenditures for
 15 personal services, contractual services, commodities and
 16 capital expenditures for each account in the county budget:
