Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of th Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after ad journment unless enacted as emergencies; and
Whereas, Franklin County has certain expenses and lia bilities which must be met as they become due; and
Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the yea 1982 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed, in orde to provide the required revenue for the county; and
Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, thes facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation a immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it
