16 **RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes**
17 **and Authorizing Expenditures of Knox County**
18 **for the Year 1982.**

20 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
21 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after ad-
22 journment unless enacted as emergencies; and

23 Whereas, Knox County has certain expenses and liabili-
24 ties which must be met as they become due; and

25 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year
26 1982 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed in order
27 to provide the required revenue for the county; and

28 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
29 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
30 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
31 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
32 peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it
