6 HOUSE AMENDMENT " \not{E} " to H.P. 2233, L.D. 2091, Bill, 7 "AN ACT to Adjust Levels of Compensation for Constitutional 8 Officers, Members of the Legislature and the Senate Secre-9 tary and House Clerk."

10 Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 5 and 11 inserting in its place the following:

12 'Sec. 5. 3 MRSA §2, 4th ¶, as repealed and replaced by 13 PL 1975, c. 750, §1, is amended by adding at the end 2 new 14 sentences to read:

15 The additional compensation to be paid to Senate and House 16 chairmen of joint standing committees who are not members of 17 leadership shall be set by the Legislative Council in accor-18 dance with a 3-tiered system of payment based on, but not 19 limited to, considerations of experience of the chairmen and 20 committee workload. In no case may the pay differential 21 exceed regular compensation by more than 12 1/2%.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to direct the Legislative Council to establish a 3-tiered payment system for House and Senate committee chairmen to be based, in part, on the experience of the chairmen and committee workload. In no case may this additional compensation exceed regular compensation by more than 12 1/2%.
