6 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2233, L.D. 2091, Bill,
7 "AN ACT to Adjust Levels of Compensation for Constitutional
8 Officers, Members of the Legislature and the Senate Secre-
9 tary and House Clerk."

10 Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and
11 inserting in its place the following:

12 'AN ACT to Adjust the Level of Reimbursement of Expenses for
13 Members of the Legislature.'

14 Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections
15 1, 2 and 3.

16 Further amend the bill in section 4, last sentence
17 (page 2, line 40 in L.D.) by striking out the figures "\$200
18 \$300" and inserting in their place the figure '\$200'.

19 Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections
20 5, 6 and 7.

21 Further amend the bill in section 8, first sentence
22 (page 3; line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the figures "~~\$25~~
23 \$35" and inserting in their place the figure '\$25'.

24 Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections
25 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14.

26 Further amend the bill in section 15 under the caption
27 "LEGISLATURE" by striking out all of lines 2, 3 and 4 (page
28 5, lines 17, 18 and 19 in L.D.) and inserting in their place
29 the following:

30 'All Other \$199,500'

31 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to
32 read consecutively.
