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6 SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 2239, L.D. 2098, Bill,  
7 "AN ACT Relating to Periodic Justification of Departments  
8 and Agencies of State Government under the Maine Sunset  
9 Law."

10 Amend the Bill in Part A by striking out all of sec-  
11 tions 17 and 18.

12 Further amend the Bill in Part A in section 19 by  
13 striking everything after the amending clause and inserting  
14 in its place the following: -

15 'Each application for, or for renewal of, a license to  
16 operate an eating establishment, eating and lodging place,  
17 lodging place, recreational camp, camping area or mobile  
18 home park within the meaning of this chapter shall be accom-  
19 panied by a fee, appropriate to the size of the establish-  
20 ment, place, camp, area or park of the licensee, determined  
21 by the department and not to exceed ~~\$30~~ \$40.'

22 Further amend the Bill in Part A by striking out all of  
23 sections 21 and 22.

24 Further amend the Bill in Part A by renumbering the  
25 sections to read consecutively.
