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SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2239, L.D. 2098, Bill,

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"AN ACT Relating to Periodic Justification of Departments

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and Agencies of State Government under the Maine Sunset

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Law."

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Amend the bill in Part A in section 28 in subsection 1

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by inserting at the end before the period the following:

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' , or unless the prescription is to correct or ameliorate

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defects and chronic conditions discovered through the early

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and periodic screening and diagnosis of individuals who are

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under the age of 21'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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Federal law prohibits copayment on all mandatory

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Medicaid services. The early and periodic screening diagno-

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sis and treatment program is a mandatory Medicaid service.

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Therefore, prescriptions issued under this program must, by

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federal law, be exempt from copayment.
