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**AN ACT Concerning State-paid Basic Life  
Insurance Benefits for Legislative Employees.**

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**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, legislative employees are hired on a year-round basis, even though some of them may actually only be employed while the Legislature is in session; and

Whereas, these employees must be prepared at any time when the Legislature goes into session to return to work; and

Whereas, for these reasons legislative employees are more like full-time employees than seasonal employees; and
