STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to improve the handling of changes in voter registration. Current law requires a registrar, registering a voter who had been previously registered in another municipality, to notify that municipality of the voter's change of residence. The only information that is required to be communicated is the voter's name and birth date. With such little information, registrars in larger municipalities have faced the laborious task of scanning through the voter registration list of each ward and precinct to find the voter's name. By adding the voter's former address to the change of voter registration notice, as this bill does, registrars will be able to more quickly locate the voter's name and remove it from the list.

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
