18 Persons Over 75 Years of Age Take Periodic

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §545-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL  
24 1977, c. 620, §2, is amended to read:

25 5. Persons 65 years of age. Any person who has  
26 attained his 65th birthday ~~but has not attained his~~  
27 ~~75th birthday~~ shall pass the vision portion of a  
28 driver's license examination before his license may  
29 be renewed.
