Since 1976, the Consumer Price Index has run from 6% to as high as 14.4% in 1980. Remedy by the Maine Legislature has fallen behind, accumulatively 25%, so that the purchasing power of the retirees' pensions has been evaporated by 1/4. Federal economists are estimating it will hold at 6 or 7% for the next 3
