18 19 20 21 22	Whereas, the provision of the social worker registration law exempting employees of nursing homes from requirements of licensing or supervision under that law will expire on July 1, 1983, if this legislation is not enacted; and
23 24 25 26 27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
28 29 30	Further amend the bill in subsection 3, by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
31	'This exemption expires on July 1, 1983 1985.'
32 33	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
34	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency

cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment further extends the exemption of nursing homes from the requirements of the social worker registration law until 1985. During this period, it is expected that the licensing board, nursing home interests and the Department of Human Services will develop safeguards to ensure properly qualified social work services to occupants of nursing homes, without unnecessary regulation.
