They shall be under the joint supervision and control of, and shall be administered by the Director of the Bureau of Forestry, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and Attorney General, and the said commissioner, director and Attorney General shall have full power in the control and management of the same, under the title of Baxter State Park Authority. The authority shall make payments to the Bureau of Forestry in lieu taxes on the basis of the state-wide annual per aere expenditures for forest fire protection for the last fiscal year for all land within the Baxter State Park area: The authority shall receive moneys available from trust funds established by the donor of the park and shall include fees collected, income from park trust funds invested by the Treasurer of State and other miscellaneous income derived from the park for maintenance and operation of the park.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

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In light of the fact that the Bureau of Parks and Recreation, the Allagash Wilderness Waterway and the Bureau of Public Lands do not pay the forest tax, it is felt that Baxter State Park should also be exempt as a state-owned public park. This bill provides that exemption by removing the appropriate statutory language requiring payment.

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
