17	AN ACT Authorizing the Use of Blue Lights
18	on Vehicles by Constables.

20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22	29 MRSA §1368, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:
23	2-A. Constables. The municipal officers of a
24	municipality may authorize the display of lights
25	emitting a blue beam of light on vehicles operated by
26	constables under the following restrictions:
27	A. The lights may be displayed only on vehicles
28	owned by the municipality;

- 1B. Only persons duly appointed by the municipal2officers as constables may display the lights;
- 3 C. The lights may only be used within the bound-4 aries of the municipality; and

5 D. The vehicle displaying the lights must dis-6 play on the vehicle the name of the municipality 7 or a similar symbol which will identify the vehi-8 cle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

10 This bill includes the municipal constable as an 11 authorized agency for the use of blue lights in con-12 nection with motor vehicle law enforcement.

13 The constable is charged with motor vehicle law 14 enforcement under Title 30, chapter 213, subchapter 15 III-A, within the municipal jurisdiction. As such a 16 positive means of identification must be available to 17 insure compliance with instructions and provide 18 public confidence of bona fide intent.

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
