1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

9 30 MRSA §5055, sub-§5, as amended by P&SL 1975, 10 c. 147, Pt. C, §15 and as repealed and replaced by PL 11 1981, c. 522, §1, is repealed and the following 12 enacted in its place:

5. Treasurer of State. An amount equal to 5% of the receipts from the taxes imposed under Title 36, Farts 3 and 8, and credited to the General Fund, plus an amount equal to \$237,000 of the receipts from the tax imposed under Title 36, Part 3, shall be transferred by the Treasurer of State to the Local Government Fund on the first day of each month, beginning July 1, 1983.

The Treasurer of State shall distribute the balance
in the Local Government Fund on the 20th day of each
month, beginning July 20, 1983.

24 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency 25 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on 26 July 1, 1983.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The purpose of this bill is to amend the 29 state-municipal revenue sharing formula by increasing 30 the percentage of receipts turned over to municipali-31 ties to 5% from 4%. This measure will provide more 32 General Fund revenues to municipalities.

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
