18 Weapon While Under the Influence of Intox-
19 icating Liquor or Drugs.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 25 MRSA §2036 is enacted to read:

24 §2036. Carrying concealed weapon while under influ-
25 ence of liquor or drugs

26 Any person who carries a concealed weapon while
27 under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs
28 or a combination of liquor and drugs or while having
29 0.10% or more by weight of alcohol in his blood is
30 guilty of a Class C crime.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make carrying a concealed weapon while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs a criminal offense.

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
