IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE

AN ACT to Establish a Fixed, Uniform
Hunting Season for Game Birds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7455, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, § 1, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7455-A is enacted to read:

§7455-A. Birds

1. Season established. There shall be an open season on game bird hunting from October 1st through the last Saturday in November. The commissioner may not modify this season except as provided in subsection 2.
