AN ACT to Change the Date of the Special
Muzzle-loading Hunting Season.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the original bill establishing a special muzzle-loading hunting season terminates, by its own terms, on March 1, 1983; and

Whereas, the termination and subsequent reenactment of another muzzle-loading hunting season bill would create confusion among members of the public; and

Whereas, this confusion can be eliminated by the adoption of this bill as an emergency measure; and
