without charge, to every person except dealers, manu	
facturers and holders of transporter registratio	
plates whose vehicle is registered under this Title	
Such plates shall be of a distinctly different colo	
or shade each year and shall be in such form as th Secretary of State may determine; and shall bear th	
numerals of the year of issue or the last 2 numeral	
of said that year, the word "Maine" or the abbrevia	-

height, and on plates issued for passenger vehicle	
for private use, hire cars and trucks, there shall b
