17 AN ACT to Change the License Plate Slogan.
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
20 follows:

21 29 MRSA §110, first ¶ is amended to read:

22 The Secretary of State shall furnish suitable
23 number plates, seals and other distinguishing marks,
24 without charge, to every person except dealers, manu-
25 facturers and holders of transporter registration
26 plates whose vehicle is registered under this Title.
27 Such plates shall be of a distinctly different color
28 or shade each year and shall be in such form as the
29 Secretary of State may determine; and shall bear the
30 numerals of the year of issue or the last 2 numerals
31 of said that year, the word "Maine" or the abbrevia-
32 tion "Me." in letters not less than 3/4 inch in
33 height, and on plates issued for passenger vehicles
34 for private use, hire cars and trucks, there shall be

1 placed at the bottom thereof in letters not less than
2 3/4 inch in height the ~~word "Vacationland."~~ words
3 "Pine Tree State." The numerals of the register
4 number thereon, except on motorcycle number plates,
5 shall be substantially not less than 3 inches high.
6 The Secretary of State may select and issue a special
7 distinguishing letter, mark or design for number
8 plates issued for any temporary or other special
9 classes of registration and for use on motorcycles,
10 trucks, trailers and tractors which are required to
11 be registered under this Title.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 The purpose of this bill is to change the state
14 license plate slogan to "Pine Tree State" from
15 "Vacationland."
