COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 63, L.D. 69,
Bill, "AN ACT to Exempt Carriers of Wood Products
from Cargo Insurance Requirements."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting
clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, carriers of logs or pulpwood are cur-
rently required to carry cargo insurance at addition-
al costs to their operations; and

Whereas, a significant number of these carriers
will have to renew or obtain these policies for the
current season if action is not taken promptly; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,'

Further amend the bill in that part designated
"§2708." by striking out in the 7th and 8th lines
from the end (page 2, lines 8 and 9 in L.D.) the
underlined words "unfinished wood products" and
inserting in their place the underlined words 'logs
or pulpwood'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency

1 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
2 when approved.'

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment clarifies the application of the
5 bill's cargo insurance exemption and adds an emer-
6 gency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
