23	§3186. Misuse of fuel assistance									
24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	Any person who under any governmental program designed to provide assistance to defray, avoid or otherwise reduce the cost of home heating and who, for consideration, sells, transfers, releases or otherwise conveys the right to that assistance or the physical fuels provided under that program commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$250 shall be imposed. Any person found guilty of violating this section shall also be denied any addi- tional benefits under that program for the remainder									

1	of	the	benefit	year,	or	the	calendar	year,	whichever
2	is	longe	er.						

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STATEMENT OF FACT

4 The purpose of this bill is to penalize those 5 persons who receive government fuel assistance, prin-6 cipally firewood, and sell it to others and keep the 7 cash. Such practices distort the intent of the fuel 8 assistance program. This bill exposes persons who 9 engage in this conduct to a civil penalty of \$250 and 10 loss of benefits.

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
