31	Residential Services Program \$ 90,000

If these federal funds are not taken advantage of this year, they will no longer be available to provide the support services.

12	All Other	100,000
13 14 15 16 17 18	Provides funds for assessments for potential boarding home residents to be conducted by community case management agencies. The funds would provide for 5 case managers statewide to conduct boarding home assessments.

22 23 24 25	Provides sufficient funds for cost reimbursed boarding homes to pay for allowable costs based on audits of reasonable costs.

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5 6 7	This bill allocates funds between the Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to provide case managers for the assessment of boarding home residents and for the development of case plans for the provision of mental health and social services for residents.
8 9 10	It also allocates funds to the Bureau of Maine's Elderly to develop 50 units of shared, group or congregate housing.
11 12 13	Lastly, it allocates funds to the Boarding Home Account in the Department of Human Services to reimburse boarding homes for additional allowable costs.
