Amend the bill in the second paragraph by adding
at the end a new sentence to read:

'This paragraph shall not be amended to permit any
person, firm or corporation to keep open a place of
business on any Sunday, except Sundays between
Thanksgiving and Christmas, unless that amendment to
this paragraph is submitted to the voters of the
State at a referendum.'
